ECTS-grading Scale

ECTS grade	Definition
A	EXCELLENT – outstanding performance with only minor errors

E	SUFFICIENT – performance meets the minimum criteria
FX	FAIL – some more work required before the credit can be awarded
FX	FAIL – considerable further work is required

4,1 – 5,0	Nicht ausreichend	FAIL – no longer meeting minimum requirements
