

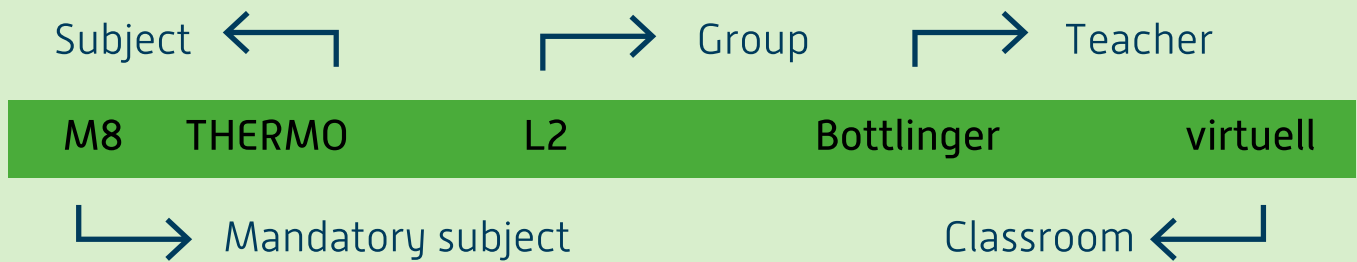
The construct of semester planning in the Department of UW/UR

The lectures and events to be taken are based on the curriculum of the respective degree program. In the semester planning, these are indicated with the number of the respective semester and the abbreviations as follows:

Bachelor's degree program:

L: Sustainable Business and Technology

Application example:



- the first abbreviation (M8) stands for mandatory subject; the digit on the side is the number of the subject in the curriculum.
- the second abbreviation (THERMO) stands for the lecture subject.
- the third abbreviation stands for the group (L represents SBT); the number behind the group (2) stands for the semester for which this course is offered.
- the fourth (Bottlinger) is the name of the Professor offering the course.
- the fifth abbreviation (virtuell) refers either to the room in which the lecture takes place or its online format.

This is the course "Thermodynamics" with Prof. Dr. Bottlinger for SBT students in the second semester. The lecture will take place virtually.
