<b>If an admission is granted and you accept the admission offer, the following documents have to be submitted!</b>	
<b>1. Confirmation of Health Insurance</b>  EU-Citizens: EU-Citizens can be exempted from the obligation for health insurance if they can provide evidence of health insurance in their country of origin. For this purpose the form E128 or the European Health Insurance Card "EHIC" is needed which you have to present during the registration process. Non EU-Citizens: All students are subject to compulsory health insurance. Non-Eu-Citizens have to buy a statutory or private health insurance.	<input type="checkbox"/>
